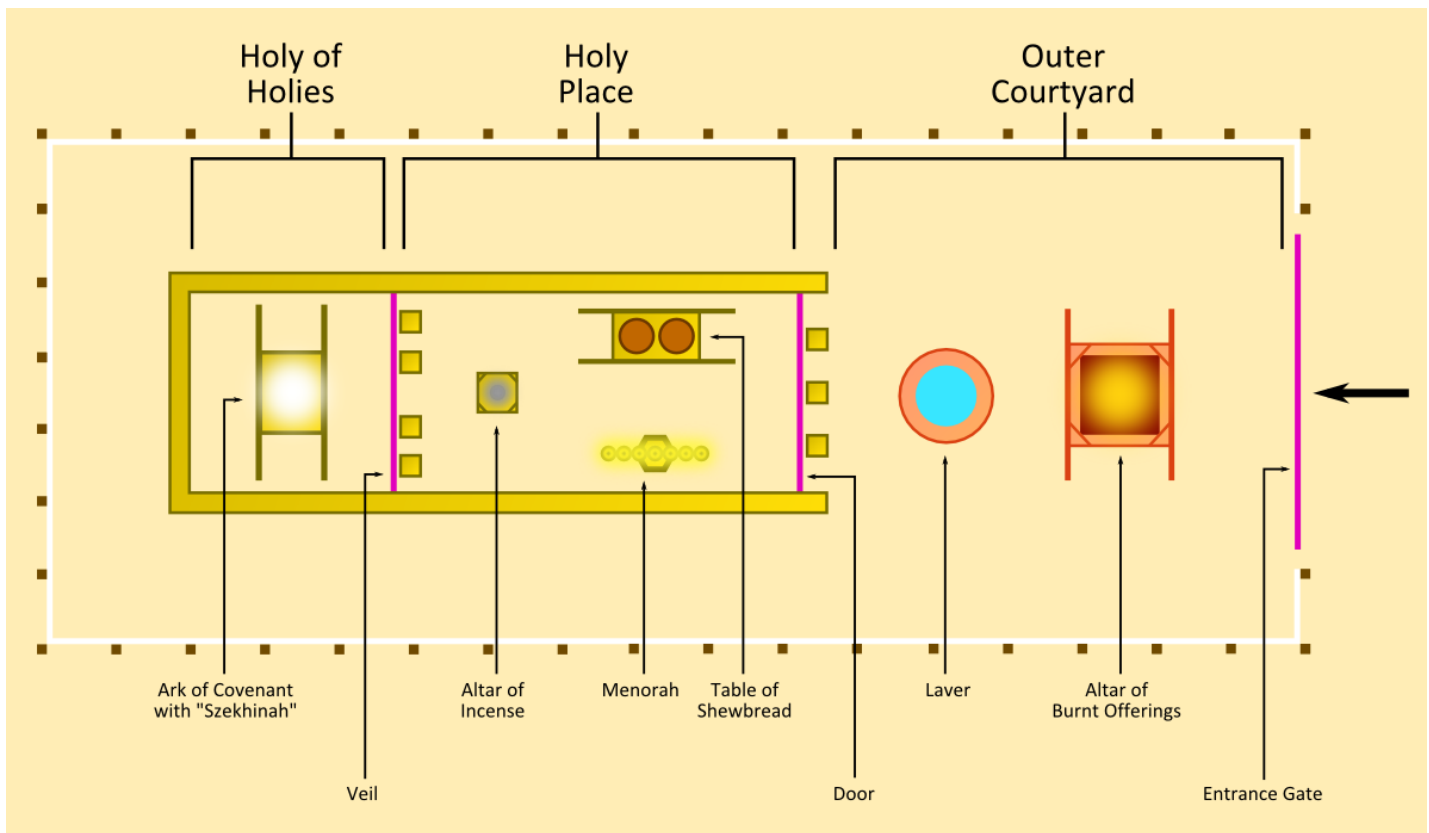


THE TABERNACLE PRAYER

- Father, I desire to pray today, so I come to Your mountain right NOW seeking You.
- Anoint me, Lord! Because Your anointing enables me to do the work You have given me.
- Only by Your anointing can I fulfill Your plan for my life.
- It was You Lord, who commanded Moses to build the tabernacle in the wilderness.
- It was You, Lord, who dwelt there and met Your people there.
- You, Lord, made the Tabernacle the place the Israelites worshiped, to illustrate Your pattern of worship. Father, the Tabernacle shows me the sequence of entering Your presence and effectively activating Your anointing for me!
- I desire more today. I thank You for the tabernacle model through Moses, in Jesus, and in Heaven.
 - I thank You for the Courtyard with the Brazen Altar and the Laver.
 - I thank You for the Holy Place with the Candlestick, Table of Showbread, and Altar of Incense.
 - I thank You for the Holy of Holies where the Ark of the Covenant and Your Mercy Seat reside.
- Today, according to Your Word, I am a priest in Your temple, my body (the temple of The Holy Spirit).
 - My spirit is like the Holy of Holies.
 - My mind is like the Holy Place.
 - My body is like the Courtyard.
- Come, Lord Jesus! Work through me, through my spirit, through my mind, through my body.
- I directly worship You, Lord, through the temple of my spirit, my mind, and my body.
- I am a priest unto the Lord. Jesus, You are the High Priest of Heaven.
 - Lord, teach me my priestly duties today.
 - Teach me according to Your ordained pattern of approaching You in prayer, God.

THE BRAZEN ALTAR

Sacrifice of Jesus on the Cross

Lord, in my mind I imagine entering the Tabernacle and I see the Brazen Altar in the Tabernacle Courtyard. I remember the different offerings presented at the Brazen Altar: sin, trespass, burnt, thanks, and reconciliation. These foretold the sacrifice of Jesus Christ at Calvary. I recognize the tremendous cost of sin.

Lord, I have this CONFIDENCE - I believe the Cross of Jesus Christ replaces the Brazen Altar for me today. The blood of Jesus Christ replaces the blood of animals, one sacrifice for all time through Jesus Christ. My sin is forgiven. I am declared righteous through the cross. No guilt and shame for me today; I have a clean slate. I will enjoy the Glory of God today. The **Shekinah Glory** is in me. *This is my bold confession and proclamation!*

Lord Jesus, through Your shed blood, You conquered sin and death. **You conquered the principalities of the world and the devil.** Give me sanctification and fullness of the Holy Spirit through the blood of Jesus. Any hold that the world or the devil had on me is canceled and broken right now in Jesus name! Because of the blood, I am free!

You hung on the cross and took my infirmities, I am healed. Sickness is illegal in me. I am healed today! By the stripes Jesus endured in the courtyard of Pilate, I am healed!

Through the Cross, through Your blood, I am redeemed from the curse. You hung on a cross so the Abrahamic blessing would be mine. I am a blessed person! I am no longer under the curse. I am under the blessing of Christ today, in my home, work, ministry, and family. There is no poverty, no curse for me. You became poor for me so that I can be rich in Jesus Christ. In Christ, I am redeemed completely from any negative thinking. No cloudy thinking for me today, only clarity on my freedom from the curse and freedom from poverty. This is a major blessing of the blood of Christ.

I am redeemed from death and hell. Through His death on the cross, resurrection, and ascension, I am with Jesus spiritually according to Scripture. I see His redeeming grace flowing to me now.

Thank You, Lord Jesus, that my mind is renewed in You as I pray this way, claiming these truths, worshiping You. Thank You for renewing me from a mind that was clouded with lies and negative thoughts. I have nothing to do with the filthy things of the world. I reject the lies. I cut off every tie with darkness, in Jesus' Name.

Lord, clarify my vision of myself as an adopted child of God, a member of Your family of priests. Make me aware of my new identity – a new person in You, a new creation through the blood of Jesus Christ.

I don't have an identity crisis. I have a clear identity in Jesus Christ!

- I will not accept the devil's messages sent to me today.
- My mind is no longer victimized by the devil's lies.
- I am a NEW CREATION. I am HOLY. I am SANCTIFIED. I am BLESSED. I'm GOD'S CHILD. The SPIRIT OF GOD rests on me!

Every day that I renew my mind, I confirm and affirm my new identity. I worship Jesus and His sacrifice for me.

SUMMARY

Through the Blood of Jesus I am:

- Adopted into Your family as a child of God.
- Ordained as a priest in Your royal priesthood.

The Blood has delivered me:

- From sin to RIGHTEOUSNESS.
- From the world and the devil to the THRONE OF GOD and the HOLY SPIRIT.
- From sickness to HEALTH and HEALING.
- From a cursed mindset of poverty to GOD'S BLESSING, THE ABRAHAMIC BLESSING.

I get to experience GOD'S GLORY every day. I discard my cloudy identity of the past and receive a CLEAR IDENTITY in Jesus Christ today! All this happens through the cross and the blood of Jesus Christ. I worship Jesus at the Brazen Altar in the Courtyard of the Tabernacle.



THE LAVER

Repentance

Lord, I invite You to expose sin in me. Lord, I step to the Laver, where I clean my conscience daily like taking a bath or shower. Just as the priests wash their hands, feet, and faces at the Laver, I look at myself in the Laver, as a mirror to my conscience. I evaluate my heart as I reflect on the Ten Commandments, pursuing a clear conscience. I repent to remove the guilt because You are Holy. I can't drag my guilty conscience into Your presence. You won't allow it.

- **1st Commandment – You shall have no other gods before me.** *Do I worship any other Gods? Do I selfishly put myself ahead of worshiping Jesus?* There is only one God, in three persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.
 - Forgive me, Lord, for dishonoring You by entertaining other gods.
- **2nd Commandment – You shall make no idols.** *Do I bow to any idols? Have I placed my role as husband/wife, father/mother, or my career position ahead of my role as a priest unto the Lord? Am I giving the first fruits of my day to something else? Am I worshiping graven images of money or power?*
 - Forgive me for dishonoring You by worshiping idols.
- **3rd Commandment – You shall not take the name of the Lord your God in vain.** *Do I call **any** of God's names in vain?*
 - Forgive me for dishonoring You by taking any of Your names in vain. I choose to honor You.
- **4th Commandment – Keep the Sabbath day holy.** *Do I honor God by keeping the Sabbath holy? Hebrews 10:25 says, **Don't stop meeting together with other believers, which some people have gotten into the habit of doing. Instead, encourage each other, especially as you see the day drawing near.** Do I prioritize Sunday as a day to attend church and serve in the Lord's house? Do I keep the Sabbath holy and set aside for the Lord?*
 - Forgive me for dishonoring Your Sabbath day commandment. I want to add value. Teach me Your ways!
- **5th Commandment – Honor your father and your mother.** *Do I honor my parents or blame my parents for my problems? Hebrews 13:17 says, **Obey your leaders and submit to them—for they keep watch over your souls as those who will give an account—so that they may do this with joy, not groaning; for this would be unhelpful for you.** Do I dishonor those You put in authority over me – pastors, government leaders, etc.? Do I gossip about them?*
 - Forgive us, Father, for our negative cultural influence that disrespects our parents and dishonors You. May I be free from that influence! Forgive me for dishonoring my parents and any authority over me. I choose to honor my pastor and other leaders. I bring honor to You today. Forgive me for dishonoring You, my Father in heaven.
- **6th Commandment – You shall not murder.** *Do I kill by hating? In what ways am I programming my mind or the minds of my children to hate or be angry or hold prejudice against anyone?*
 - I forgive others right now. I release all offenses. I repent of any angry words spoken. Forgive me for dishonoring You through angry words and hatred. O Lord, deliver me from an angry, bitter heart. Only You can do this. I have failed in controlling my anger. Only You can give me the grace to have victory over this.
- **7th Commandment – You shall not commit adultery.** *Do I commit adultery or entertain lustful thoughts?*
 - Forgive me for dishonoring You by being sexually impure. Cleanse me and make me holy! Give me the fear of the Lord. Help me to walk softly before You. Deliver me from the idolatry of the human body. Deliver me from unhealthy appetites and unwholesome affections.
- **8th Commandment – You shall not steal.** *Am I stealing from You, Lord, or anyone? Am I squandering or misusing Your gifts to me? Malachi 3:8 says, **“Would anyone rob God? Yet you are robbing Me! But you say, ‘How have we robbed You?’ In tithes and offerings.”** Do I withhold tithes or offerings? Am I dishonest in my work or life, taking anything without paying for it or without permission?*
 - Forgive me for poor stewardship, for stealing or squandering time, talents, and treasures from You, Lord. I choose to bring my tithes and offerings. Forgive me for any dishonest gain and give me the grace to return or restore what I have taken wrongly. Make me a good steward of Your temple, my body, and all the things You've given me to manage as a priest in Your temple.
- **9th Commandment – You shall not bear false witness against your neighbor.** *Am I witnessing falsely? Do I lie or withhold the truth?*
 - Forgive me for lying. Forgive me for being a false witness of Jesus. Forgive me for believing false ideas and vain philosophies. I want to be a true witness of Jesus Christ. Forgive me for dishonoring You by trusting false things. Give me the way, the truth, and the life in Jesus Christ!

Laver



- **10th Commandment – You shall not covet.** *Am I coveting? Am I coveting things You don't want me to have – my neighbor's house, car, reputation, spouse, children, lifestyle, or abilities? Covetousness is the first sin – the downfall of Eve and Adam that caused their disobedience. Am I coveting anything? Am I coveting my lifestyle?*
- All blessings are from the Lord. I am grateful for my spouse, my children, my home, and my career. All abundance is from You, Lord. You are the source of all blessings and gifts. Forgive me for dishonoring You by wanting anything outside of Your will for me. God, You are a good God – an abundant God. You desire to bless me more than I understand! I release control of my time and money. I make open spaces in my life. I want to receive Your abundance and blessing! Fill my open spaces with Your will and purpose for my life. All this happens through the cross and the blood of Jesus Christ. I worship Jesus at the Laver.

THE HOLY PLACE

Candlestick - The Holy Spirit

- I open the curtain and walk into the Holy Place. There I see the candlestick, symbolic of the Holy Spirit, the sevenfold Spirit of God: wisdom, understanding, counsel, power, knowledge, fear of the Lord, and holiness.
- Holy Spirit, I welcome a deeper, more intimate relationship with You today. Through Your anointing give me Your wisdom to help me to solve all the problems I face.
- Give me Your understanding so that I may understand the deep truths of God, living those truths and passing them on to others.
- Counsel me so that I will follow Your narrow path. Lead me to wisely advise others on how to live and resolve problems.
- Give me tremendous power so that I might be used by You to heal the hearts and lives of others and defeat the schemes of the devil. **Acts 1:8 says, "But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses."** You are the same yesterday, today, and forever.
- Holy Spirit, increase my knowledge of the Bible.
- Give me a keen fear of the Lord so I may walk very softly before You and not commit any sin.
- Give me holiness through Your presence, O Lord!
- The Father worked in the forefront during the Old Testament. Jesus worked in New Testament times. I live in the Age of the Holy Spirit. I want to depend on You, Holy Spirit, not my own strength. I don't want to catch quail with my bare hands. I want You to blow the quail into my camp.
- Holy Spirit, You are a Holy Person with a will and emotions, not a genie. Forgive me for treating You impersonally. You should be welcomed, loved, caressed, adored, and worshiped.
- You are my senior partner. You are my Lord. I depend upon You. Let's go, Holy Spirit. Thank You for Your anointing. Let's work together. I will follow You.
- **John 4:24 says, "God is spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truth."** As a true worshiper of the Holy Spirit, I stand on the truth of Your Word. **I boldly Tell the Truth and Shame the Devil.**
- **John 16:13 says, But when He, the Spirit of truth, comes, he will guide you into all the truth. He will not speak on his own; he will speak only what he hears, and he will tell you what is yet to come.**



Jesus, You introduced the Holy Spirit in **John 14:26: But the Advocate, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you all things and will remind you of everything I have said to you.**

And hope does not put us to shame, because God's love has been poured out into our hearts through the Holy Spirit, who has been given to us. Romans 5:5 What a great gift!

"Guard the good deposit that was entrusted to you—guard it with the help of the Holy Spirit who lives in us.

2 Timothy 1:14

Thank You for living in me! Help me in all things!

But you, dear friends, by building yourselves up in your most holy faith and praying in the Holy Spirit. Jude 1:20

Pray in the Holy Spirit.

Table Of Showbread - Word of God

- Thank You for Your Logos word which is written in the Bible. Thank You for Your Rhema word, the inspired Word of God. Over 7,000 promises of God are written in the scriptures. The Logos written word is potentially mine. Rhema is God's inspired word made alive in my heart today for a specific application.
- Knowledge can become deceptions without Your truth and revelation. Lord, I want true faith from You today! Operating on knowledge alone can be disobeying You. I want to obey You in all things today.
- Naming and claiming promises my finger lands on in scripture is a dangerous business. Lord, waiting on You for Rhema is the way of the mature disciple.
- Jesus, You spoke of this truth in **Matthew 4:4: *Man does not live by bread alone but by every word that comes from the MOUTH of God.*** Give us this day our daily bread. **Luke 11:3**
- **All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting, and training in righteousness, so that the servant of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work.** **2 Tim 3:16-17**
- **Open the eyes of their hearts, and let the light of Your truth flood in. Shine Your light on the hope You are calling them to embrace. Reveal to them the glorious riches You are preparing as their inheritance.** **Ephes 1:18**
- Lord, reveal Your specific Word, Your Rhema Word for my life today. Teach me to wait on You each day to receive Your inspired Word personally.



Read a section of the Bible, seeking a personal Word from God. Write down what God shows you. Allow the Word of God to apply to your life since His Word is alive and active. Allow God to lovingly shine His light of hope on you. Write down or memorize verses that encourage you and help you renew your mind. Hide God's Word in your heart.

Altar Of Incense - Praise and Worship

- Father, You are omnipotent. You can do anything and I will believe You. Give me perfect faith in Jesus Christ.
- I CHOOSE by exercising my free will today. I choose to believe YOU! I reject fear and doubt. I will never choose either of them.
- I trust You. I trust Your Word. You are always with me. You will never leave me or forsake me. John 14:20 says You are in me! That's where You live. Make Yourself very real to me today!
- I choose to lift my praise to honor and magnify You, Holy Lord. (Take a moment to sing/worship)
- **Through Jesus, therefore, let us continually offer to God a sacrifice of praise—the fruit of lips that openly profess his name.** **Hebrews 13:15 NIV**
- **Praise be to the LORD God, the God of Israel, who alone does marvelous deeds.** **Psalm 72:18**
- **Enter his gates with thanksgiving and his courts with praise; give thanks to him and praise his name.** **Psalm 100:4**
- **Praise the LORD. Give thanks to the LORD, for he is good; his love endures forever.** **Psalm 106:1**
- **In a loud voice they were saying: "Worthy is the Lamb, who was slain, to receive power and wealth and wisdom and strength and honor and glory and praise!"** **Revelation 5:12**



Praise God for who He is. Remember His greatness! Call out His names!

THE HOLY OF HOLIES

Mercy Seat

- I enter the Holy of Holies humbly with faith and confidence. I see the blood of Jesus Christ sprinkled on the Mercy seat. Lord, I am filled with humility and awe and reverence to be acceptable in Your presence by the blood of Jesus. It is finished! All my debts have been paid in full. I am free from bondage to sin of any kind.
- Through the Blood I have the impartation of the righteousness of Jesus Christ! I am God's righteousness in Christ. I come into the presence of God without feeling any condemnation because of what Christ has already accomplished for me.
- The blood is the answer – it is the final solution for me.
- I praise You, Father, for the wonderful, incredible blessing of righteousness imparted to me, Your servant, through Your Son, Jesus Christ.
- Thank You, Lord, that the devil is my defeated enemy through the Blood of Christ. I will not bow to the fear of the roaring lion. He is bluffing and he is defeated. The devil has no authority in my life.



Ten Commandments in the Ark Of The Covenant

- Christ's blood annuls the power of the law that would make me work for righteousness. The law is my mirror now, not my master. It helps me to clean my face, my conscience. The law does not condemn me.
- Christ is my Lord. His blood is the final, finished work that redeems me. The law shows me how to please God and helps me understand when I have grieved and disobeyed God – but it doesn't condemn me. The blood has changed that forever for me as a New Testament Christian.
- No works or achievements are required for my salvation; only believe by faith in the finished work of the Cross.
- Thank You, Father, that the blood of Jesus is my deliverance from sin. The blood is my impartation of Christ's righteousness. The blood brings freedom from fear of Satan. The blood is my freedom from the law of the Old Testament. The blood is my freedom from human works to achieve right standing with You, O Lord!
- **Eph 2:8-10 For it is by free grace [God's unmerited favor] that you are saved through [your] faith. And this [salvation] is not of your own doing, it is the gift of God; it is not because of works [the fulfillment of the Law's demands], lest any man should boast. For we are God's own workmanship, recreated in Christ Jesus that we may do those good works which God planned beforehand for us, that we should walk in them [living the good life which He prearranged and made ready for us to live].**

Prayer In The Holy of Holies

- God, You chose me to stand in Your presence. I prepared my heart and now bring personal requests to You. I intercede for others as the priest intercedes for the people of Israel.
- God, thank You for hearing my petitions. I humbly bring requests with faith and confidence that You will hear and answer according to Your will.

PRAY!

- **Yourself**
- **Family**
- **Friends**
- **Church**
- **Work**

- Pray for those closest to you and work out from there.
- There's power in spoken word, so pray out loud whenever possible.
- Some people choose to write prayers to stay focused and remember what they prayed. Praise God for His faithfulness when you see answered prayers.
- Pray through your prayer list, which you continue to develop. Your list should serve as a reminder, but never limit you.

- Remain sensitive to the Holy Spirit as you pray. Allow Him to lead you in new directions. Consider prayer an intimate conversation.

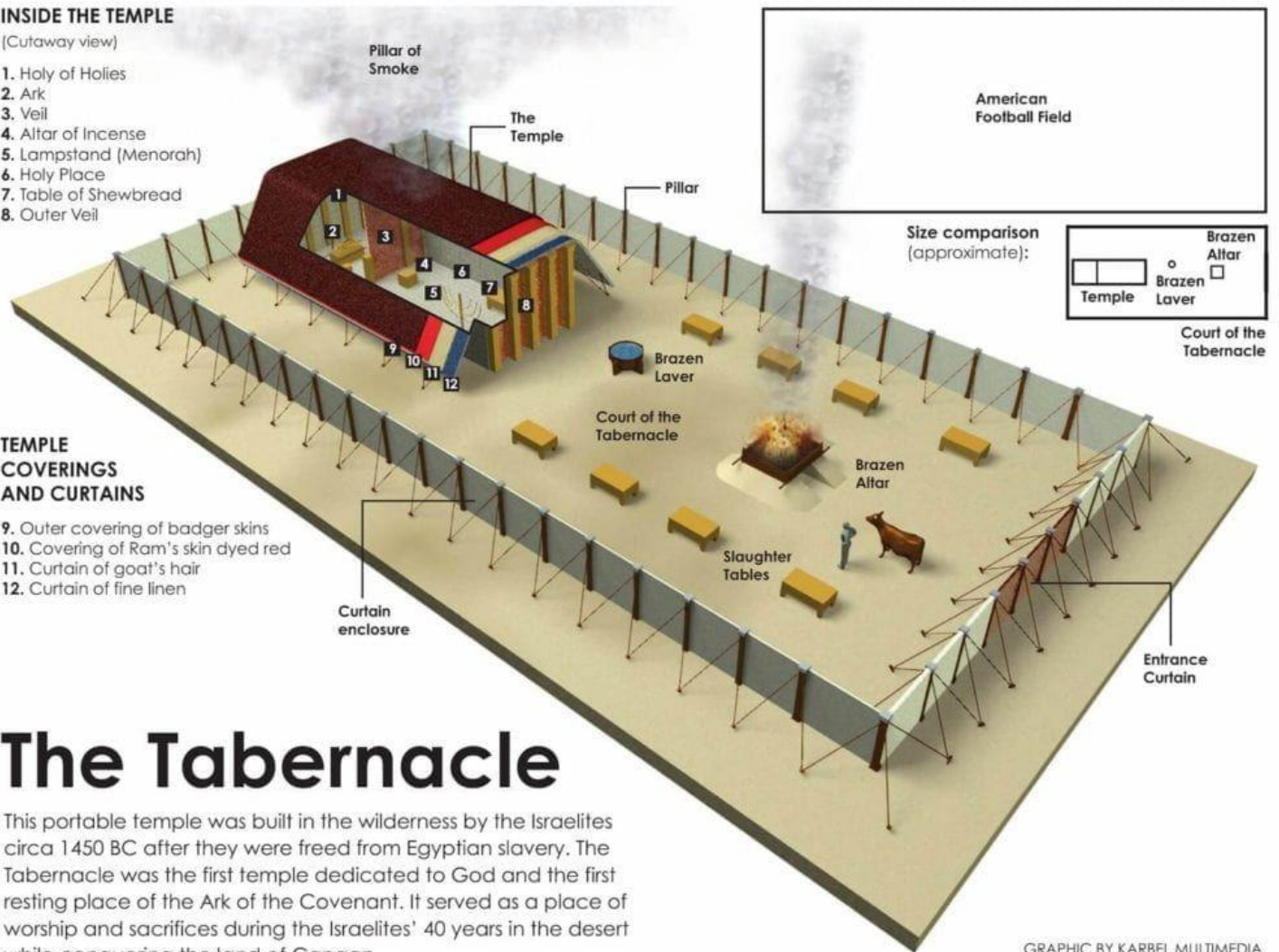
INSIDE THE TEMPLE

The Tabernacle

This portable temple was built in the wilderness by the Israelites circa 1450 BC after they were freed from Egyptian slavery. The Tabernacle was the first temple dedicated to God and the first resting place of the Ark of the Covenant. It served as a place of worship and sacrifices during the Israelites' 40 years in the desert while conquering the land of Canaan.
